From I-385 South/I-26 East, take the I-126 East exit, EXIT 108B, on the LEFT toward DOWNTOWN/COLUMBIA. Merge onto US-76 East. Turn RIGHT onto SUMTER ST, just past MAIN ST. 1820 SUMTER ST is on the LEFT.

From I-26 West

Charleston:
From I-26 West towards COLUMBIA, take the I-126 exit, EXIT 108B, on the LEFT toward DOWNTOWN/COLUMBIA. Merge onto US-76 East. Turn RIGHT onto SUMTER ST, just past MAIN ST. 1820 SUMTER ST is on the LEFT.

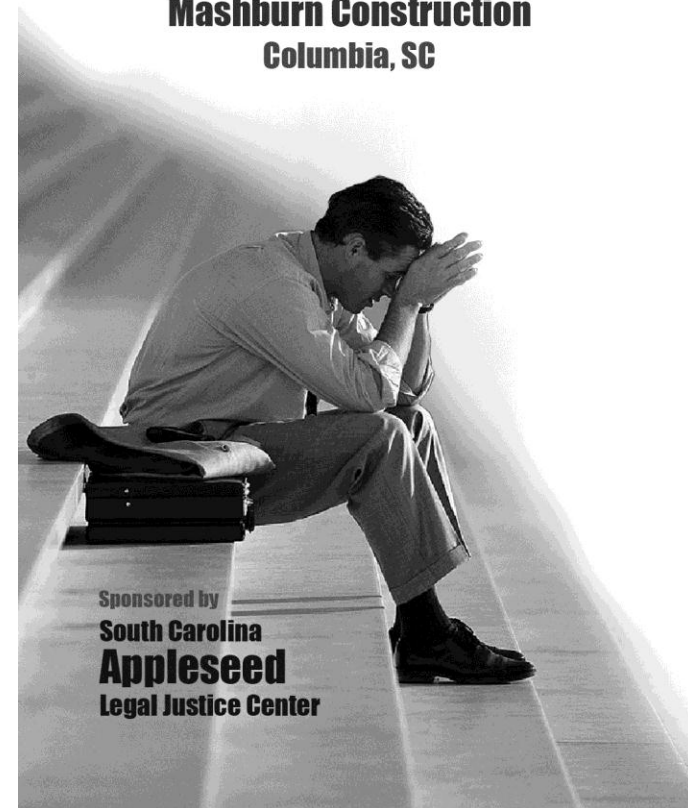
